As you are aware, the Board has implemented Grading System with 20% weightage to internal Assessment from this academic year onwards. To avoid any inconvenience, a lot of care needs to be taken in communicating the correct required information to this Office within the specified period/s. This Office has sent a few proformas during the course of the year to get the required data so as to enable precise computation of the results.

You are requested to forward the Assignment Marks in all the Subjects and Grades in the School Assessment Subjects for the General Stream to this Office in the enclosed proforma (only for General Stream) **within 10 days of receipt of the school list with** ...2.

Seat Numbers of the candidates of March/April 2011 HSSC Examination. The Grades/ Marks in the proforma **must be sent in hard and soft copy** with the **soft copy in Excel Format**. The format may be downloaded from the Board's website.

The Schools **should not send the marks in the format/s circulated** along with the Circulars earlier regarding the submission of marks of internal assessment pertaining to Assignments and Grades in School Assessment Subjects.

As the scheme of 20% weightage to the Internal Assessment is **not applicable to the Vocational Stream**, the grades of the students of **Vocational stream awarded in School Assessment Subjects and On the Job Training (OJT) as notified vide circular No.36 dated 15/09/2010 should be sent as per the earlier practice.**

It may be noted that marks in Assessment/Project for General stream students are out of 10 for the internal assessment component and the Grades in the School Assessment Subjects for both General Stream Students & Vocational Stream students are to be awarded on the nine (9) point scale.
