The Heads of all recognised Higher Secondary Schools
within the jurisdiction of this Board.

Sir/Madam,

This has reference to our Office letter No. GBSHSE/ACAD/BOS/10/6365 dtd. 4/6/2010 (General Stream) and letter No. GBSHSE/ACAD/BOS/10/6356 (Vocational Stream) dtd. 7/6/2010 wherein it is informed to all the concerned about introduction of Grading system on nine point scale and also introduction of internal assessment scheme for which 20% marks are reserved.

Now it is to further clarify that:

1. The Internal Assessment Scheme will not be applicable to Vocational subjects. However, the Higher Secondary Schools may follow the distribution of topics from Mid-Term and First-term for uniformity.
2. In case of School Assessment Subjects such as Physical Education, N.C.C., YRC etc. the Higher Secondary Schools should hereafter convey to the Board the grades obtained by the students on nine-point scale instead of the current practice of five-point scale. The grades so obtained should be intimated to the Office of the Board soon after the school list of HSSCE candidates (with seat numbers) is received by the School.
3. With regard to the Internal Assessment Scheme in General Foundation Course for std. XII (Vocational) notified vide this Office letter No. GBSHSE/ACAD/BOS/10/6356 dtd. 7/6/2010, regarding Grading for public Examination of HSSC (Vocational), the Internal Assessment Scheme in General Foundation Course should be read as “Two assignments are compulsory as part of Unit I as per Circular No. 20 dated 21/6/2005. Unit II would continue to be a case study/Project Report of an Entrepreneurial concern”.
4. The marks procured by the students (of the General Stream) for the First Mid Test and First Terminal Examination are to be submitted to the Office of the Board by 15th September and 10th December of every year in the enclosed format only (in hard and soft copies). The format can also be downloaded from the Board’s website.

This is to further inform that the software for data entry of students particulars in respect of HSSC Examination application forms are already uploaded on our website <www.gbshse.gov.in>. The Higher Secondary Schools may download the same and take up the exercise to prepare the CD with the information about their students strictly according to the School General Register. Alternatively, a copy of the software may be procured from the Board’s Office by bringing a writeable CD/pendrive.

If this exercise of data entry of students particulars from the School General Register is taken up right now, the Schools will have enough time for checking and finalising the contents of the CD, without any errors so that back references can be well avoided.
