**GBSHSE/EXAM/HSSC/MARCH/APRIL-2009/**

**CIRCULAR No. 56**

To,  
The Heads of all recognized  
Secondary & Higher Secondary Schools  
under the jurisdiction of this Board.

**Read:-** Board's Circular No. 40 dated 08/09/2008.

Sir/Madam,

By above mentioned Circular, it was informed to all the Secondary & Higher Secondary institutions under the control of this Board that the exemptions earned by a repeater candidate in previous S.S.C./H.S.S.C. Examination will be allowed to claim only up to five and three more consecutive examinations respectively, after their first attempt.

However, the Board has now decided that the repeater candidates be given the benefit to claim the exemptions earned by them even beyond the limits of turns set out in above referred Circular No. 40 dated 08/09/2008.

All the recognized institutions have already submitted the examination application of their students, including repeater, for the ensuing examination of March-April 2009 and it may happen that, some of the repeater candidates who may be now appearing for their seventh/fifth attempt or more for SSC/HSSC examination respectively have not claimed their past exemption as per Circular No. 40 referred to above.

Now by virtue of the above mentioned decision of the Board, it is open for these repeater candidates to claim their past exemption and answer the examinations in only remaining subjects in March/April 2009.

Therefore, all the Heads of Institution are hereby requested that the repeater candidates who are covered by above mentioned fresh decision and whose applications are already submitted to this Office adhering to the restrictions spell out in Circular No.40 dated 08/09/2008, may be allowed to exercise their discretion afresh to claim to carry their past exemption and opt to appear only in the remaining subjects in the ensuing examination of March/April, 2009, not withstanding the revision of the pattern.

If there are any such cases of repeater candidates who opt for above concession, a list of such candidate after suitably seeking their consent for fresh option, may be submitted in the enclosed proforma, so as to reach this Office on or before **5<sup>th</sup> January, 2009.**

It is further informed that question papers in **Old N.C.E.R.T. Syllabus** will not be set for the ensuing S.S.C./H.S.S.C. examination and all the repeater candidates of Old N.C.E.R.T. Syllabus will have to answer the paper set in New N.C.E.R.T. Syllabus with new pattern in force. However, the repeater candidates who have answered the exam for the first time in March/April, 2006 and subsequently for H.S.S.C. and March/April, 2007 and subsequently for S.S.C. will have the facility to answer their remaining subject/s under the same M.S.B. Syllabus.
