Candidate(s) shall not be allowed to leave the Examination hall before **one hour from the commencement of the examination.**
- All important and relevant instructions for answering the public examination, circulated vide this office circular **No. 53 dated 04/10/2006** shall be strictly followed by all students.
- Under no circumstances examinations shall be postponed even though any day is declared as a public holiday.

Guidelines for the conduct of SSC/HSSC Public Examination 2020

Role of Headmaster/Principal


1. To take responsibility to drop and pick up to and from the Examination Centre/ Sub Centre by following proper protocol of social distancing, face cover etc.
2. All staff apart from the supervisors including the non-teaching staff should be made available for the smooth conduct of Examination as per the requirement of the Centre Conductor for SSC/HSSC.
3. No parents are permitted in the vicinity of 200 meters of the Examination Centre/ Sub Centre. The same may be informed on top priority.
4. HOI to handover a seating arrangement slip to each and every student bearing Examination Centre/ Sub Centre name, seat no, block number and floor number. The data should be collected from the Conductor.
5. Volunteers will be positioned at the entry points to further assist the candidates to reach to their respective blocks to avoid any crowding at a given time.
6. Candidates will be allowed to leave the Examination Hall one by one blockwise at the end of the Examination.
7. Volunteers will again direct the candidates towards the exit points where school buses are parked while following social distancing, further to be dropped by the school.
8. The school PTA may also be involved if required.
9. All Higher Secondary Principals shall assist the SSC Centre Conductors for the conduct of SSC Examination .They shall make available their staff to the SSC Centre Conductors as per requirement.
10. .All Secondary School Headmasters shall assist the HSSC Centre Conductors for the conduct of SSC Examination and They shall make available their staff to the HSSC Centre Conductors as per requirement as per requisition.

Role of the Centre Conductor (HSSC & SSC)

1. To handover data to the HOI under the jurisdiction of the Main Centre. (Examination Centre/ Sub Centre name, seat no, block no and floor no of the candidates)
2. Take assistance of volunteers from Hr Sec. School staff for medical help. A team of three including a leader will be responsible to over look the task. They may have

a stall with provision of Glucose, small sealed water bottles, masks and sanitizers to provide if required. Such teams to be deployed at each Sub Centre and Main Centre. The team leader will also arrange Medical Officer from the nearby PHC in case of need.

3. If there is no Higher Secondary schools nearby, a team of volunteers from secondary schools may be deployed for the purpose.
4. If more volunteers from the Higher Secondary schools are available, may be used for assisting the candidates in the premises.
5. Teachers of Higher Secondary schools may be requisitioned for supervision purpose if required after confirming their disqualification for confidential work for SSC exam and vice versa if disqualified may be appointed as volunteer.
6. From the volunteer staff of SSC schools under the centre one person per school to be appointed at each entry point of the premises of centre gate.
7. Next, 2 persons or as per requirement shall be deployed inside the premises of the centre or on each floor to direct the candidates to the blocks as per their slips and to see that there is no crowd and social distancing is followed.
8. The above volunteers will work in the same way at the conclusion of the Examination every day. And Candidates to be allowed to leave the premises block wise.
9. The Conductors to allow candidates to carry transparent water bottles, sanitizers and to wear masks in the Examination Hall.
10. Examination blocks to be sanitized before the commencement of the Examination.
