

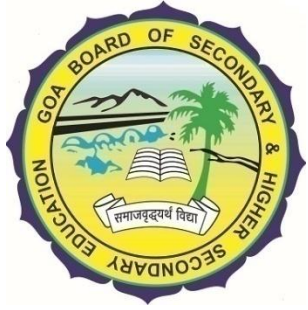

- The unprecedented situation arising due to Covid-19 in the State,
- Paramount importance to the safety of Candidates and examination Personnel,
- GBSHSE (Board) vide Circular No: 22 dated 03/06/2021 cancelled the Board Exams for Class XII which were to be held from 24th April 2021 to 18th May, 2021.

- ❖ Circular 29 dated 25/06/2021, Policy document for Tabulation of marks of Class XII an objective criterion developed by the Board to prepare the result.
- ❖ Result committee constituted in each of the Higher Secondary School headed by Principal of the school.
- ❖ Class XII result is prepared based on internal assessment of class XI (30%), class XII (40%) and performance of class X (30%).
- ❖ Moderation of marks is done to maintain subject average based on historical performance of the Higher Secondary School.
- ❖ Opportunity to appear in the Board Examination to candidates who are not satisfied with this result after forfeiting result prepared through objective criterion.

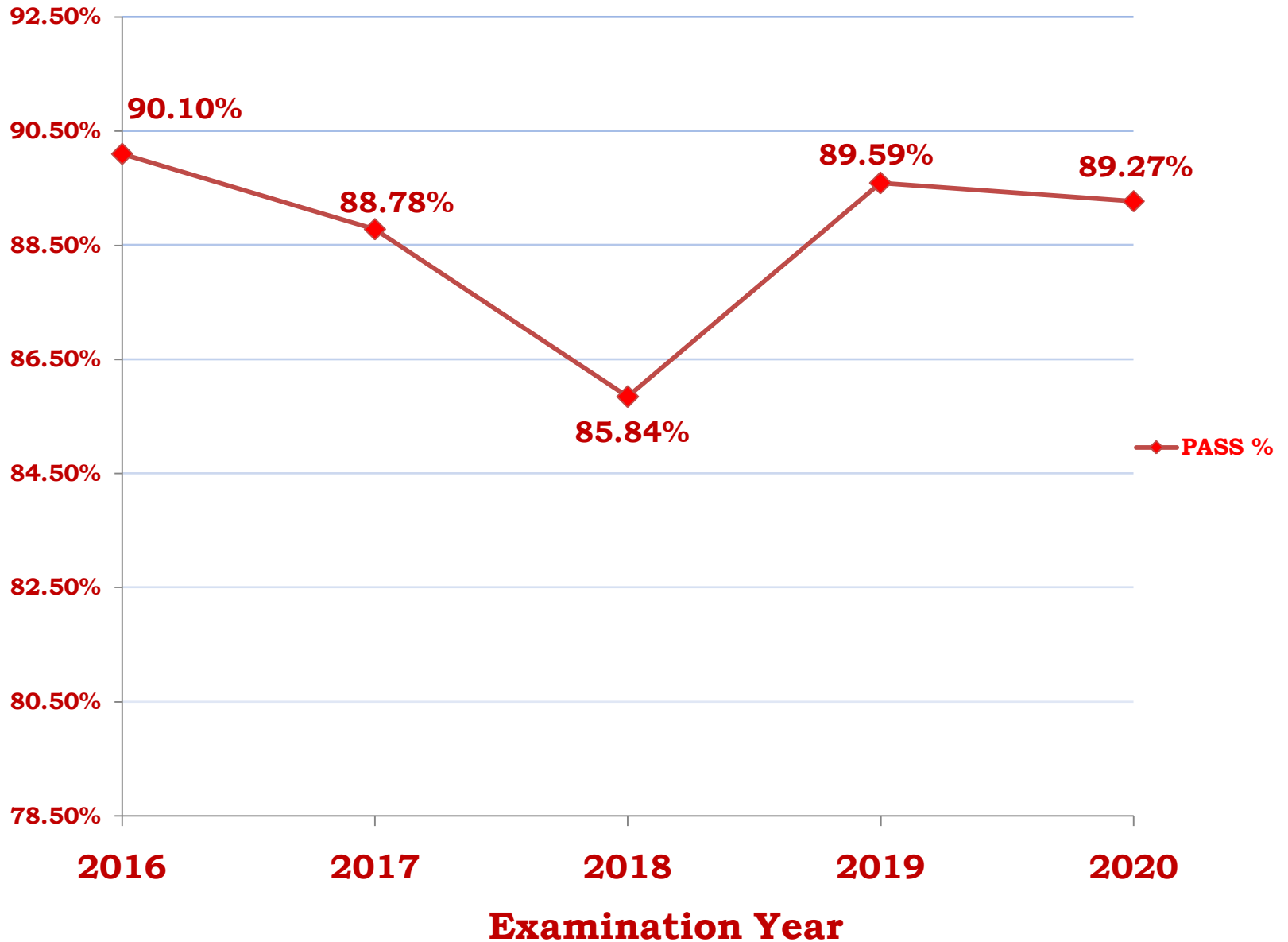
Distribution of Marks for External Theory component based on Internal Exams conducted by the Higher Secondary Schools
