- The unprecedented situation arising due to Covid-19 in the State,
- Paramount importance to the safety of Candidates and examination Personnel,
- GBSHSE (Board) vide Circular No: 20 dated 24/05/2021 cancelled the Board Exams for Class X which were to be held from 13th May 2021 to 4th June, 2021.

- ❖ Class X Board result based on objective criterion developed by the Board.
- ❖ Opportunity to appear in the Board Examination to candidates who are not satisfied with this result.
- ❖ The facility of ATKT (Allowed To Keep Terms) in class XI to unsuccessful Candidates of class X.
- ❖ Entrance Examination for admission to Science stream and Diploma courses as of now 6744 registered for the Exam.

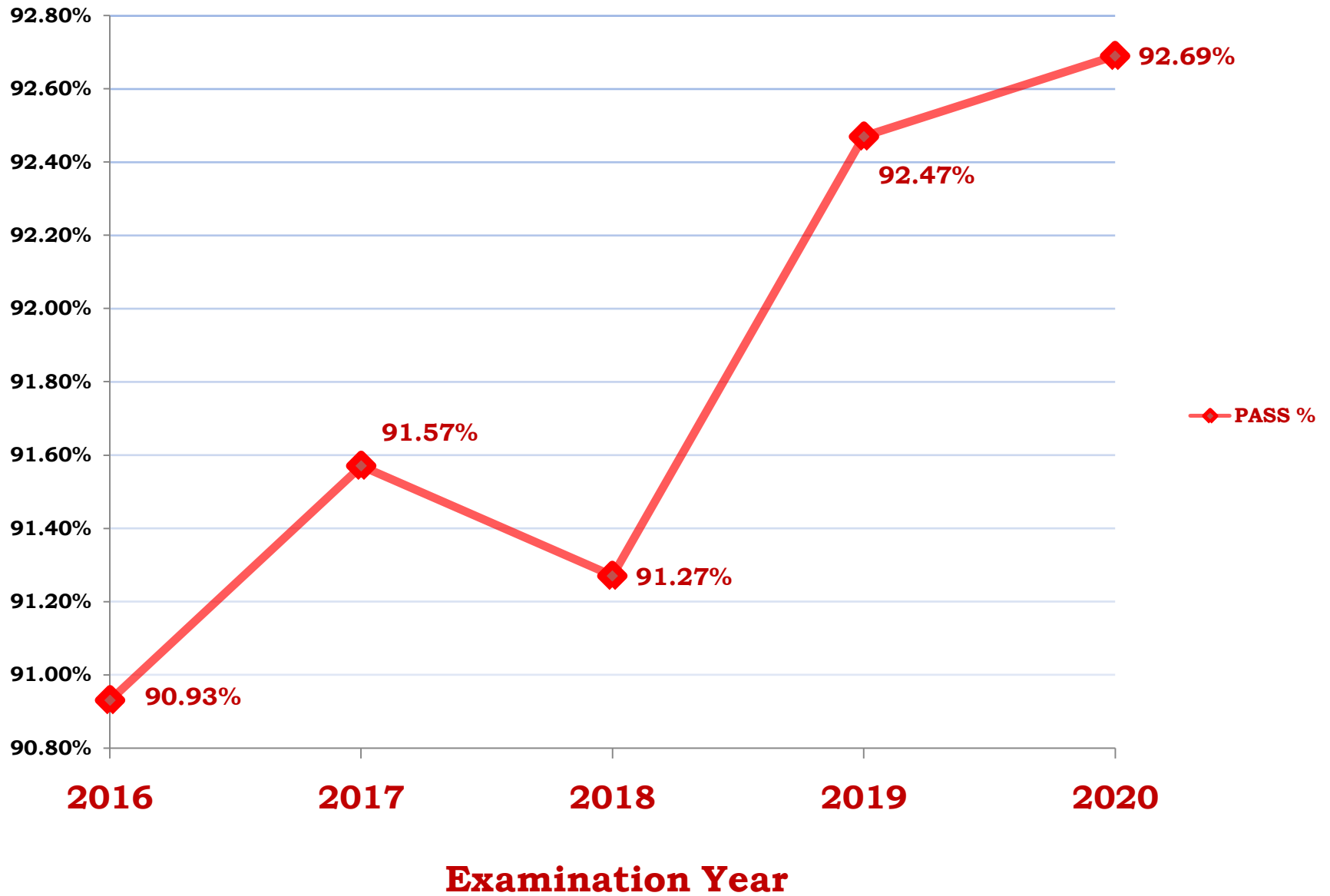
