Sub:- Clarification on Circular No. 16 dated 08/04/2022 regarding pattern of Assessment for Class IX and Class XI for the Academic Year 2021-2022

Sir/Madam

With reference to above cited subject and as per the request from President, Higher Secondary Principal Forum, pertaining to point I (c) and II (b) of aforesaid Circular no. 16 dated 08/04/2022, it is clarified as follows :-

- A. To avoid misuse of the scheme of the examination, as mentioned in Point I (c), all Exams are made compulsory and absent in any one of them should be taken as needs improvement.
- B. In case any student who has not submitted the assignments / projects or remained absent for any test (Formative/ Innovative), only on genuine reasons he or she shall be given opportunity to complete the assignment/ project or to answer the missing test before declaration of final results of Class IX / Class XI. However, if the absence of student is justified on genuine reasons such as medical etc. then the average of the test marks is to be allotted provided the student qualifies the final examination of Class IX/ Class XI.
- C. Absence of student for any Term examination shall be treated as needs improvement and student will have to answer the supplementary examination in the subject(s). However, the absence may be justified on medical grounds in which case the average of the Term marks is to be allotted provided the student qualifies the final examination of Class IX/ Class XI.

D. Since Class IX and Class XI examination is being held by school itself, absence is justified on medical grounds or genuine reasons. However, it is not applicable to public examination conducted by this Board.

### E. Supplementary Examination:-

*As per Circular No. 16 dated 08/04/2022, Supplementary examination will be awarded irrespective of number of subjects in which the student scores less than 33% on aggregate of 100 marks, this mean, supplementary examination could be awarded to the student with remark needs improvement in all six subjects or less than that.*

F. Regarding the Remarks on the final report card it is clarified as follows:

(a) Qualifies for next class includes

- (i) Passed and Promoted to Class XII / Class X.
- (ii) Condoned and Promoted to Class XII /Class X.
- (iii) Promoted with Sports Merit Marks to Class XII /Class X.

(b) If the remark is needs improvement then mention the subject in which he / she has to appear in the supplementary examination.

(c) If there is no improvement in the supplementary examination i.e. if the students' scores less than 33% on aggregate of 100 marks then the final result shall be needs improvement in class XI/ class IX.

For further clarification or queries the heads of the institution are requested to communicate officially to this board and not to rely on lookalike circular posted on social media groups.
